CATHOLIC EDUCATION SERVICE: (2nd Collection) This weekend on 9th/10th September there will be a second collection for the Catholic Education Service. The Catholic Education Service (CES) acts on behalf of the Catholic Bishops Conference to support Catholic Education. They have a strong and positive working relationship with the British and Welsh Governments, sharing the aims of high academic standards for all and increased parental choice. Catholic schools make up 10% of the national total maintained schools. There are over 2000 Catholic Schools, Academies and colleges in England. educating over 800,000 pupils.

This collection provides the bishops of England and Wales with resources to support Home Mission, the spread of the Gospel in our own country.
