CATHOLIC EDUCATION SERVICE - 2ND COLLECTION: This weekend there will be a second collection for CES. The Catholic Education Service (CES) acts on behalf of the Catholic Bishops Conference to support Catholic Education. Catholic schools make up 10% of the national total of maintained schools. There are over 200 Catholic schools, academies and colleges in England educating over 800,000 pupils. The Catholic Church and the Church of England together provide one third of all schools in the country. The CES is the chief negotiating and advisory body on matters affecting all aspects of Catholic Education, and it also provides financial assistance for schools transport in rural areas.
