

## THE PARISH CHURCH

Our Parish Church of St Vincent's is now open for worship on a daily basis. As yet we are not free to conduct any religious service such as the Mass or other acts of worship. The church building is open for private worship each day of the week. The time of opening from Monday to Saturday is from 10.00am - 12.00 noon and in the evening from 5.00pm - 6.00pm. Everyone who comes to worship is asked to remain vigilant and observe the norms as set out by the competent authorities. There are thirty two places at any one time to worship. The actual seating is marked to comply with the 2 metre distance. Visiting as a family a whole bench can

Permission has been granted for churches to be open for private worship. This is very good news indeed. Sacramental adoration in our parish has been a daily practice. We hope this is the first step which will lead to regular worship where the sacramental life practice will return to normal.

So far no public celebrations are able to take place.
